### Explanatory Notes

**Year 11 Students:** Students at a school registered with TASC.

**Continued to next year of education and training:** A student must achieve at least 1 credit point towards their TCE (or successfully complete a TASC-accredited Preliminary course) in the next year. The study can be at any Tasmanian school, Registered Training Organisation or organisation delivering TASC recognised formal learning.

**Achieved the TCE:** Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained the Tasmanian Certificate of Education.

**Achieved an ATAR:** Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank.

**Attained a VET Certificate:** Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained a Vocational Education and Training Certificate.

**Values of NR:** Not reported for results based on cohorts of fewer than 5 students.
